

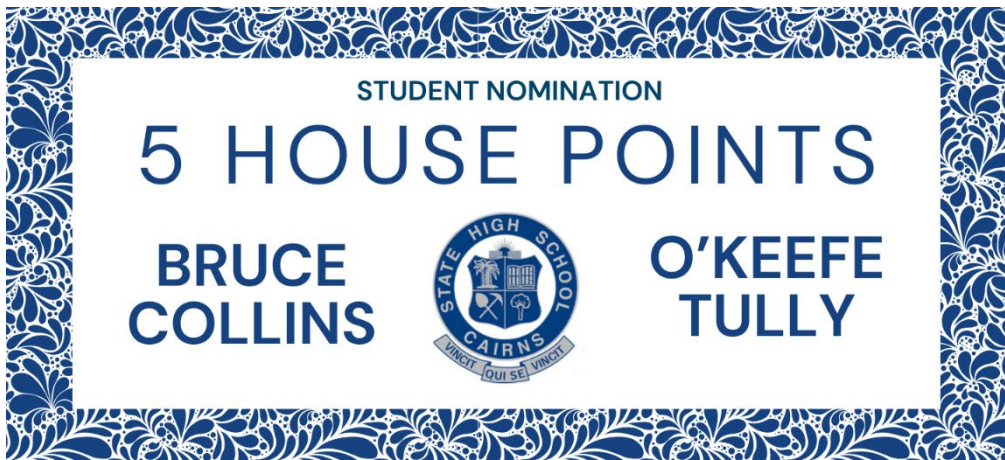


**Wellbeing**
