## Chairperson's Report - May 2022

#### 1. Achievements

A very successful 2021 including:

- CSHS Chorale were awarded the winner of the Qld State Schools Choral Fanfare Creative Generations for most outstanding choral ensemble in Queensland
- Outstanding success at the 2021 Cairns Eisteddfod. Came first in 16 of 17 sections entered!
- Two music nights were successful in raising close to \$7000 for the music department, acknowledging the hard work of parents involved in the Music Support group
- 4 of our 2021 Year 12 graduates were selected to study at the Queensland Conservatory of Music

#### 2022 so far:

- AGM held on 23 Feb. New executive team voted in. Request for position holders to be ratified. Thanks to Bill Gane for his 8 years of services as Chairperson.
- 3 General meetings held, 27 current members.
- CSHS Chorale performed for the Director General of Education at the FNQ Principal's Conference on 17 March.
- CSHS Orchestra Masterclass on 20-21 March. Associate Professor Peter Luff, Associate Professor at Queensland Conservatorium Griffith University (QCGU) came up to work with the Orchestra.
- String masterclass with Professor Patricia Pollett 27-28 April
- Instrumental Music night on Friday night at Crosswell Hall raised approx. \$2500.
- Samples are being finalised for the proposed new CSHS music performance uniform.

### 3. Approvals

- Music subcommittee purchased a Square point of sale machine. Approval from P and C requested to set up.
- Further approvals for Music support group executive to be signatories on main music P and C account at Bendigo Bank
- Gambling Community Benefit Fund for 2022 next round August for grants up to \$35 000. Music department would like to apply for a grant for the following instruments:
  - o Tubular Bells \$10,000 they are in 1 of the pieces that we are playing for orchestra at the moment
  - 1 x Fox Bassoon \$9250
  - o 1 x vibraphone to replace broken one \$8,000
  - o 1 x xylophone to replace 35 year old instrument \$8,500
  - Upright piano in the hall over 30 years old and needs to be replaced \$15,000
