Dear students, parents and carers

Term 3 is an extremely busy time for Year 10s as they prepare for their senior pathway in 2026. This ultimately involves them deciding to either continue Years 11-12 and attain their QCE, or to leave school and pursue further study, or enter the workforce at the end of Year 10. Throughout the term, the school provides many information sessions for students and parent/carers to be supported on this journey and adequately prepared to make this important decision. In their *Career Connect* classes, students become familiar with the subjects being offered for their Senior Schooling pathway at Cairns State High School. Students will use the knowledge and experiences gained throughout *Career Connect* to select Senior School subjects that will progress their career pathway - as well as meet pre-requisites for higher education.

All Year 10 parents and carers are invited to participate in the personalised information session to better understand:

- The Queensland Senior curriculum
- The requirements for attaining the Queensland Certificate of Education (QCE)
- The requirements for university entry with an ATAR
- Vocational Education Certificate qualifications on offer at the school
- Becoming familiar with important senior secondary terms, such as 'general' and 'applied' subjects, ATAR, QCE, credits, and university-bound v. vocational-bound subjects/pathways
