- All students must choose an English and Maths subject, unless approved by deputy principal or negotiated at SET Plan interview.
- Students must choose a subject or option on all 8 lines, including two back-up subjects.
- ATAR PATHWAYS. For a Tertiary Entrance score (ATAR), It is recommended that students choose a minimum of five General subjects, plus one Applied/Certificate subject. Students must study an **ENGLISH** subject to obtain an ATAR.
- Students must choose 5 subjects on lines 1-5 and then have the option to choose a subject or a negotiated pathway option for Line 6.
- The school recommends 5 GENERAL SUBJECTS AND 1 APPLIED/VET SUBJECT as the ideal pathway for ATAR eligible students.
- <u>The 6th line includes school-based subjects and also negotiated options</u> including but not limited to external certificates; work experience and/or school-based traineeship/apprenticeships; Tafe at school; university programs etc. If choosing a negotiated pathway, please provide details.
- Please select a Line 7 and Line 8 option. If you are interested in auditioning for a Centre of Excellence program, please write the program name.
- Ensure that selected subjects meet pre-requisites outlined in the Year 11 and 12 Subject handbook.
- Some Senior workshop subjects may have early start times.
- Exams will commonly be held on Thursday mornings. It is compulsory for students to attend.
