2022 - Year 12 Student Resource Scheme

Cairns State High School operates a voluntary Student Resource Scheme (SRS) under the guidance of the Department of Education. The aim of the scheme is to provide students with necessary textbooks (electronic or hard copy), classroom resources, associated learning materials and online learning resources at a financial savings to parents. Parents have the choice of participating or non-participating in the scheme. Parents who choose not to join the scheme will be required to privately purchase all the various textbooks, classroom and online learning resources and practical equipment and materials listed below. The cost in sourcing these resources is higher than the cost of taking part in our Student Resource Scheme and also more time consuming.

The school's Student Resource Scheme fee is broken into 4 sections:

- SRS A Fee:** Includes the core fees applicable to all students in the year level cohort.
- SRS B Fee:** Elective subject fees that are determined by each student's individual timetable.
- C Fee:** Additional Educational Programs – Instrumental Music Program, Outside of School Hours Programs including Centre of Excellence
- D Fee:** Vocational Education Training Fees

Textbook and Resource Allowance (TRA) – 2022 \$295.00

Students enrolled at Cairns State High School by Friday 25/2/2022 are eligible for the Queensland Government allowance that provides financial assistance to parents/carers of eligible secondary school students and independent students for school education resources. The TRA is a reduction to the annual SRS participation fee. This amount is deducted from the SRS during the invoicing process.

Please note additional charges not included in the SRS Fees:

- Excursions – Excursions will be invoiced separately and must be paid for prior to the excursion to be able to participate
- Optional Activities – Activities e.g. competitions, locker hire, Euroka etc. payments will be made directly to the office. These will not be invoiced.

Payment Arrangement

Several payment options including a single payment for the full year's fee or term instalments are available. An instalment plan can be negotiated with the school.

Any unpaid invoices, will be managed according to the department's Debt Management Procedure and may result in the student being excluded from the scheme and/or from participating in non-curricular activities until payment is made.

Payment Method

- When paying by BPOINT, please use the Customer Reference Number (CRN) and invoice number printed on the invoice received from the school. If unsure of the CRN, please contact the school.
- Use Centrepay to make regular deductions from your Centrelink payment towards your SRS Fee. Centrepay is a voluntary and easy payment option available to Centrelink customers.
