

2026- Year 10 Student Resource Scheme

Cairns State High School operates a voluntary Student Resource Scheme (SRS) under the guidance of the Department of Education. The aim of the scheme is to provide students with necessary textbooks (electronic or hard copy), classroom resources, associated learning materials and online learning resources at a financial savings to parents. Parents have the choice of participating or non-participating in the scheme. Parents who choose not to join the scheme will be required to privately purchase all the various textbooks, classroom and online learning resources and practical equipment and materials listed below. The cost in sourcing these resources is higher than the cost of taking part in our Student Resource Scheme and more time consuming.

The school's Student Resource Scheme fee is broken into 3 sections:

- 1. SRS A Fee: Includes the core fees applicable to all students in the year level cohort.
- 2. SRS B Fee: Elective subject fees that are determined by each student's individual timetable (invoiced separately by subject in February)
- C Fee: Additional Educational Programs Instrumental Music Program, Outside of School Hours Programs including Centre of Excellence

Textbook and Resource Allowance (TRA) - 2026 \$164.00

Students enrolled at Cairns State High School by Friday 28/2/2026 are eligible for the Queensland Government allowance that provides financial assistance to parents/carers of eligible secondary school students and independent students for school education resources. The TRA is a reduction to the annual SRS participation fee. This amount is deducted from the SRS A during the invoicing process.

Additional charges (not included in the SRS Fees) include:

- 1. Excursions Excursions will be invoiced separately and must be paid for by the due date. Permission Forms must be signed for invoicing. If Permission and Payment is not received your student will not be able to participate in the excursion. Refer to 2026 Proposed Financial Excursion List for approx. costs and schedules
- 2. Optional Expenses/Activities e.g. Competitions, Locker Hire, Euroka etc. Payments are to be made directly to the office. These activities will not be invoiced.

NB: Personal stationery items are not provided as part of the SRS. See below the Student Subject Requirement List.

Payment plans

Being mindful of the impact of cost of living increases and other financial pressures affecting families, Cairns State High has set up a system of managing Student Resource Scheme and fees obligations by working with families to set up a payment plan. Many families have taken advantage of having a payment plan over the years. Parents/Carers are encouraged to set up the plan at the start of the school year so that ongoing regular payments take place. A payment plan that has been operating in an established manner is a requirement for engagement in excursions if fees are not paid in full.

- Payment Plans (Direct Debit or Centrepay) can be set up through the Main Office for SRS and Subject Fees only
- EFTPOS, Cash payment can be made at Reception

Extra-curricular Activities

Excursions, camps and other activities beyond the normal learning program take place at different times throughout the year. These are invoiced separately. All school fees need to be paid in full or there needs to be an established payment plan for students to engage in Extra-curricular Activities.
