Elected Student Members

Eligibility

To be eligible for election as an elected student member, a person must:

- not have been convicted of an indictable offence, unless the Minister gives approval under the Act (s.93);
- be a student attending Year 10, 11 or 12 of the school;
- attend a meeting called for the purpose of electing student members; and
- submit a completed nomination on time.

Term of Office

The general term of office for an elected student member is a calendar year.

Election process

- 1. For the student election, the principal is the returning officer, or must appoint another person to be the returning officer for the election.
- 2. A student election may take place at the same time as (or combined with) other elections at the school involving students. For example, the election of the school's student leaders.
- 3. At least one but not more than two student members must be elected.
