

Cairns High Program of Excellence Audition Process - Drama: Year 7 - 2026

Drama auditions are being held on Thursday May 8 2025 between 3.30pm and 5.30pm. Auditions are 30min and parents are able to book a time once the enrolment process has been completed. You will be emailed a link.

- 1. Auditions will be in groups of 10. There will be two teachers in drama room. They'll do a warm up and make sure students are supported and comfortable.
- 2. Students choose one of the Monologues below to present off by heart, costumes and props are not required.
- 3. During the audition teachers will be looking for evidence in the following 3 criteria.

a. CHARACTER DEVELOPMENT (examples include)

- i. Was the student 'present' during the entire audition
- ii. Were the student's choices and expression consistent with the emotional tone of the piece?
- iii. Did the performer have a solid understanding of the script?
- b. **PHYSICALITY** (examples include)
 - i. Sustained level of Energy
 - ii. a strong sense of presence maintained throughout the piece
- c. VOICE (examples include)

- i. vocal work with a clear understanding of text, situation and character.
- ii. voice mechanics (enunciation, articulation, intonation, projection) that were clear and varied
